In 2010, the Gibraltar Society for Cancer Relief set up a professionally run bereavement counselling service run by local counsellor, Madeline Andlaw.

Although care and support of bereaved people had always been provided by the charity, this had been done on a more amateur basis, and it was now felt that a professional service would be of benefit to those people whose grief was not resolving as they had hoped.

“Sessions are held twice a week to help adults and children who have recently lost a relative or close friend to cancer, deal with the grieving process, enabling them to achieve acceptance and remember the deceased with fond memories”
