Friends of Cancer Relief

Becoming a friend of Cancer Relief means signing up to become a **member** of the charity. Membership of a charity can bring real benefits both to the work of the charity and for society more generally.

People have a variety of motivations for becoming a member of a charity. For some it can be about access to specific information and support, but more importantly it can provide a sense of contribution to and involvement in your own community.

By becoming a charity member you can provide us with a wider perspective into how the charity is seen to operate and more importantly share your different perceptions into what the needs of the community we serve might be.

What's Involved?

Membership includes a minimum annual subscription fee of **£20**. However, you can also make more regular monthly donations should you so wish.

Once a year you will receive a copy of the charity's annual report, including our financial health details and keeping you updated on all the charity's progress and future developments.

You will also be invited to attend our Annual General Meeting (AGM) where you will have the opportunity of sharing your thoughts on any charity operations and governance issues.

Personal Data Requirements

In order to join very member must:

Provide some basic personal details such as;

- Name and address
- Contact details, including email and telephone numbers.

Should you consent to provide us with your personal information we will keep a record of it on our digital membership database on our server. Only designated personnel will have access to your personal data. These details are kept so we can contact you with charity updates and for historical charity archives.

Your personal privacy is important to us. We will strive to keep your information confidential. We will not share it with any third parties. We will only use it for the reasons intended. Should you wish to have your details removed simply contact us, at any time, and we will do so.

Membership status will automatically expire after 12 months, if subscriptions are not paid. Should you choose not to renew yours, or we do not receive your annual subscription, your details will be removed from our database.
